The concept of "beginner's mind" is about approaching your Reiki practice with openness and eagerness to learn, no matter your level of expertise. The idea that "True humility is staying teachable, no matter how much you already know" underlines the importance of never assuming you've learned all there is to know.

This mindset is crucial because it keeps you open to new techniques, understandings, and ways to connect with Reiki energy, ensuring your practice continues to grow and evolve.

For Reiki practitioners, adopting a beginner's mind means treating every session as a new opportunity to learn and improve. It might be as simple as paying closer attention to the feedback your body gives you during a healing session or trying out a different way of working you've learned from a peer, even if you've been practising for years.... though we should also strive to have a simple, intuitive, clutter-free practice.
